



Biological samples: ineligibility criteria.

The nurse in charge of the sampling room, with the collaboration of the laboratory staff, must verify the suitability of the biological samples provided by the Customers.

The biological samples provided by the Customers must be sent to the Analysis Laboratory in their entirety, without requiring the user to perform any operation to optimize the sample itself (urine transfer, faeces aliquot, etc.) since errors may be introduced by the patient himself.

It is also the responsibility of the blood sampling room staff to provide suitable containers free of charge for the collection of urine and feces from patients.

Samples will not be admitted with absent, incorrect or incomplete patient identification, with absent, incorrect or incomplete information for carrying out the tests, collected in an unsuitable container (not sterile, not intact, etc.) and of insufficient volume.

Furthermore, the accompanying documents must contain all the necessary information (ticket office registration, exemption codes, date of issue, etc.).

Expired orders will not be accepted.
